### REQUEST FOR BID: Preschool trough child sinks and drinking fountain upgrades

**Location: Multiple Locations-Head Start- State Preschool (see listing of sites below)**

Foundation for ECE, Inc. is a nonprofit agency that operates multiple Preschool & Toddler Sites, funded by LACOE and CA Department of Education for Head Start, Early Head Start & State Preschool.

### PROJECT DETAILS:

#### Scope of Work:

Upgrade wall mounted troughs and wall mounted water faucet fixtures to censored non-touch faucet fixtures and new double, wall mounted bathroom trough sink.

Replace indoor and outdoor drinking fountains to single or double non-touch units (match existing) with bottle filling stations that meet ADA requirements.

**Project Completion Date: Projects must be completed by June 10, 2024**

### REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFICATIONS:

**All renovation and construction projects in excess of \$2000 must follow all required regulations, including prevailing wages Davis Bacon Act<sup>1</sup>. For more information on DBA please visit the DOL website.**

- 1) All installation work must meet manufactures specifications and recommended installation guidelines.
- 2) Vendor to provide to owner all; Packaged instructions and operations manuals, date of installation, and all warranty information.
- 3) Vendor to provide when requested S.D.S sheets to owner's representative.
- 4) All lead base material shall be treated in accordance with all State and local abatement regulations.
- 5) All bids in excess of \$2,000.00 to include provisions for the Davis-Bacon Act (DBA) Vendors are responsible for all DBA requirements and compliance. For more info on DBA vendor can visit DOL website.
- 6) All Vendor/Contractors must have an active California state Contractors license and maintain certifications and insurance required for the duration of the contract/agreement required by the state of California.
- 7) All work to be performed in a professional and timely manner.



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- 8) Contractor will be responsible for all permits and engineering required.
- 9) All work to be performed by signed contract terms and conditions provided by owners (Foundation for ECE) agent or representative.
- 10) Each project location must be kept clean at all times, trash and debris must be removed from the property by the vendor/contractor.

2. *An interview will be conducted with the contractor(s) employee(s) onsite by our agency to ensure employee(s) of awarded contractor(s) are complying with Federal Davis Bacon Prevailing wages.*
3. *Upon completion, photos of Davis Bacon Act poster posted onsite, certified payroll and pictures of completed project must be included with your invoicing.*
