REQUIREMENTS AND SPECIFCATIONS:

All renovation and construction projects in excess of \$2,000 must follow all required regulations, including prevailing wages Davis Bacon Act¹. For more information on DBA please visit the DOL website.



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- 1) All installation work must meet manufactures specifications and recommended installation guidelines.
- 2) Vendor to provide to owner all; Packaged instructions and operations manuals, date of installation, and all warranty information.
- 3) Vendor to provide, when requested, S.D.S sheets to owner's representative.
- 4) All lead base material shall be treated in accordance with all State and local abatement regulations.
- 5) All bids in excess of \$2,000 to include provisions for the Davis-Bacon Act (DBA). Vendors are responsible for all DBA requirements and compliance. For more info on DBA, vendors can visit DOL website.
- 6) All Vendors/Contractors must have an active California state Contractors license and maintain certifications and insurance required for the duration of the contract/agreement required by the state of California.
- 7) All work is to be performed in a professional and timely manner.
- 8) The contractor will be responsible for all permits and engineering required.
- 9) All work is to be performed by signed contract terms and conditions provided by owners (Foundation for ECE) agent or representative.
- 10) Each project location must be kept clean at all times. Trash and debris must be removed from the property by the vendor/contractor.

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Summary of Davis Bacon Act Requirements:

- 1. Prevailing wages and certified payroll must be included if project exceeds \$2,000 per Davis Bacon Act.
- 2. An interview will be conducted with the contractor(s) employee(s) onsite by our agency to ensure employee(s) of awarded contractor(s) are complying with Federal Davis Bacon Prevailing wages.
- 3. Upon completion, photos of Davis Bacon Act poster posted onsite, certified payroll and pictures of completed project must be included with your invoicing.
